The marked trails guide you towards the legendary sites on the Island, the Batéguier pond, shelter to many species of migratory birds, the footpaths bordered by fragrant vegetation, the ancient cannonball ovens from the Napoleonic era, and finally the Royal Fort where the Man in the Iron Mask was imprisoned.

Sainte Marguerite Island is the region's favoured setting for an excursion in preserved nature and with multiple cultural attractions. A true haven of tranquillity, this exceptional site combines nature and history in total harmony.

Among the open air spaces you will find two restaurants, a snack bar and numerous picnic areas to dine and recharge.

The underwater ecomuseum is home to 6 underwater statues off Sainte-Marguerite Island's south shore directly below the forester's lodge path.

Most divers wearing a mask and snorkel can visit the sculptures. The sculptures will evolve over time and be covered in seaweed, shellfish and benthic fauna to become an integral part of the local ecosystem.

THE MAN IN THE IRON MASK & THE ROYAL FORT MUSEUM

A historically classified site, this fortress built by Vauban houses the Royal Fort Museum which reveals the history of this site: the Cell of the Man in the Iron Mask, aquatic and terrestrial archaeological collections, murals by Jean Le Gac, Huguenot memorial...
